

THE HORSE RIDING CLUBS ASSOCIATION of VICTORIA INC.**JUMPING SUB-COMMITTEE GUIDELINES****1. OBJECTIVES**

- 1.1. To promote the HRC AV Rules relating to all Jumping Events, with particular reference to the safety of Members and horses at all levels.
- 1.2. To ensure that judging and course building standards are maintained and remain equitable across all Levels, Judges, Course Builders and locations.
- 1.3. In relation to 3b of the HRC AV Guidelines for Sub-Committees, any Member may sit on this Sub-Committee, however, preference shall be given to Official HRC AV Judges, Course Builders and Technical Delegates.

2. DUTIES

- 2.1. To organise Jump Judges and Course Design/Building Training and Refresher Sessions geographically spread, preferably at least once a year, to ensure that interested Members understand the aspects of safety together with the Rules for Showjumping, Combined Training and Horse Trials Events.
- 2.2. To organise Jump Judges and Course Design/Building Accreditation Examinations, preferably at least once a year, to ensure that the Association and Member Clubs have suitably trained Officials able to construct courses that meet the rules, the safety, and the height/width and length requirements of the Association.
- 2.3. To address specific questions/problems relating to all aspects of Jumping, as they arise from the Executive Committee, Member Clubs or Members.
