Round 1: 8th September - HRC AV Unofficial – levels 5 to Advanced, tests 1 & 2 – entries close 28th August.
Round 2: 6th October - HRC AV Official -- levels 5 to Advanced, tests 2 & 3 – entries close 25th September.
Round 3: 3rd November - HRC AV Unofficial -- levels 5 to Advanced, tests 3 & 4 – entries close 23rd October.
Round 4: 17th November - HRC AV Official – levels 5 to Advanced, tests 4 & 5 – entries close 6th November.

Conditions of Entry

- This Event will be run under HRC AV Rules and Regulations.
- Current valid Membership and Dressage Performance Cards must be presented prior to competing.
- Competitors must present to Gear Check Steward at least 20 minutes prior to first test.
- Riders must supply their own numbers for both sides of their horse.
- Registered Club Colours and approved helmets and riding boots must be worn.
- Competitors MUST ride at their assessed level and may also ride an additional test at the next level.
- Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of the posting of interim scores and must be accompanied by a \$20 deposit. Decision of the ground jury is final. No secondary protest will be entered into.
- The South Eastern Dressage Association Inc does not accept any liability or responsibility for any injury, loss or damage to any person, property or animal.
- NO refunds after the closing date unless Doctors/Vet certificate supplied within 14 days of competition, administration fee of \$20 will be deducted.
- To be eligible for a Championship in a level, a horse and rider combination must compete in 6 out of the 8 available tests for the series. Each combination may nominate for one championship level only, in either EA or HRC AV, at the time of their initial entry. Championships will be awarded in Prep to Elementary for EA tests, and in levels 5 to 1 in HRC AV.
- Points will be allocated on placings in overall classes with points allocated for 1st (30 points), 2nd (29 points), 3rd (28 points) and so on. In the event of a draw, points will be shared – for example equal 2nd will share 2nd and 3rd points, i.e. 28.5 points each.
- Volunteers are required for pencilling, test collection and other forms of assistance. Entrants are asked to supply details of a volunteer (which may be the entrant) on the entry form. Failure to provide such details may result in the entry being rejected.
- Entries will not be accepted until payment has been made. Proof of payment should be supplied with your entry form.
