- **Official HRC AV points competition, run under HRC AV Rules and Regulations:**
- Competitors must be financial member of the HRC AV.
- Current Membership and Showing Performance Cards and current Standard HRC AV entry form must be presented to the Card Secretary 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the first class
- All competitors must wear approved helmets and full Club uniform
- Competitors to supply their own numbers, to be displayed on both sides of the horse or a number holder
- Medical armbands must be worn when jumping.
