GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries will only be accepted on **Official HRCV standard entry forms**. Riders must also complete a Horsham Ag Society Inc Indemnity form and purchase a Horse Show Membership for \$25 prior to competing. (Available from Ag Show office, HRCV Ring, or with online horse entries).
2. The event is being run according to HRCV rules and regulations.
3. Membership & performance cards to be presented to secretary's office minimum of 30 minutes prior.
4. Members to supply own numbers to be displayed both sides of horse or Chest number holder.
5. Club uniform and approved helmet to be worn.
6. Protests must be submitted in writing to Event Secretary.
7. HDESC accepts no responsibility for any accident, damage, injury, illness or loss to any person, horse or property.
8. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class, to divide any section, to alter the advertised times, to refuse entry without stating a reason.
9. Medical armband must be worn in Mount most suitable
10. Protest's queries, must be received within 30 mins of results being posted & accompanied by \$30 deposit. The Ground Jury's decision is FINAL.

As per HRCV rules, refunds will not be given for scratchings unless a valid Veterinary or Medical Certificate is provided within 14 days of the show and will only be given less an administration fee of \$10.

COMMENCES: 9am in Ring 3 - Ring will conclude by 12.-12.30pm before PC Classes commence.

Current HRCV members only. Membership/showing cards and completed standard HRCV entry form must be handed in to the Card Secretary in Ring 3 by 8.30am on the day of the competition. Competitors must supply their own number. Club uniforms must be worn. Classes may be combined on the day at the Judge's discretion. Medical armbands must be worn whilst jumping. Run under HRCV rules – rider onus applies: it is the competitor's responsibility to read and understand the rules of the competition.
