Conditions of Entry

1. Ring to be conducted under HRC AV rules and regulations.
2. All competitors must be financial members of the HRC AV. Valid membership and showing cards must be handed to the card secretary by 8.30 am. Day entries must present completed Official HRC AV entry form with cards.
3. Classes may be split or combined at the Judge's discretion.
4. All competitors must supply their own number to be displayed on both sides of the horse or on breastplate.
5. All competitors must wear approved helmets, boots and club uniforms.
6. Medical armband will be required for jumping.
7. Neither The Lakes Riding Club, Camperdown P&A Society or HRC AV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
8. No refunds on unused tickets. No refunds after closing date unless a vet or medical certificate is lodged within 14 days of the event.
9. All numbered classes are eligible for High Point
10. In the event of equal placing in High Point award a countback based on highest placing in Rider Class (including Champion) shall determine the winner.
