- This competition will be run jointly under HRCav, EA and SFDC rules and regulations. HRCav rules apply to HRCav riders & tests. **1ST SEPTEMBER 2020 tests to be used.**
- Level 4 & 5 Riders assessed prior to 1st July 2020 to update points on performance cards.

- HRCav Competitors must ride at their assessed level and if chosen, a level above. If a HRCav rider is eligible to compete in both HRCav and EA tests, then they may only compete in a total of 4 tests in any one day irrelevant of the test affiliation eg: 2 EA tests and 2 HRCav tests = 4 tests.
- All riders must check in at canteen on arrival. Official competitors must present their membership cards & performance cards to Secretary/HRCav Coordinator prior to riding. All riders must present to Gear Check prior to 1st test.
- All competitors must provide their own number holders for their allocated numbers to be displayed on both sides of the horse. Approved helmets and riding boots must be worn. Official riders must wear their Club's uniform in their Club's registered colors.
- No refunds after closing date unless Doctors or Veterinary Certificate supplied within 14 days.
- Dogs to remain on lead at all times.
- All leftover hay and manure must be removed from float parking area and yards and placed in designated areas before departure.
- SFDC accepts no responsibility for accidents, damage, injury, illness or loss to any person or property.
