General Conditions of Entry:

- Only horses entered in the competition are allowed at the venue.

- Event run to HRC AV rules and regulations. Membership & performance cards to be presented to secretary's office minimum of 30 minutes before first test.
- Riders must enter at their assessed level and may enter the level above if entries permit.
- TWO Bridle or saddle blanket numbers to be provided by the rider
- Club uniform and approved helmet to be worn.
- Riders must present to gear check 20 minutes before first test.
- **Dogs are only permitted in the camping/float parking and camping area and must be tied up or on a lead at all times. No dogs allowed in the competition/administration areas.**
- Protests must be submitted in writing to the Event Secretary. The decision of the ground jury is final and no secondary protests will be entered into.
- ASPR Inc. accepts no responsibility for any accident, damage, injury, illness or loss to any person, horse or property.
- The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class, divide section, alter the advertised times, to refuse entry without stating a reason.
- All refunds are subject to a \$15 administration fee per day per entry.
