RULE CHANGES – EFFECTIVE 1ST JANUARY 2023

SHOW JUMPING

<p>Event rules 5.7 And 24.7</p>	<p>Add Event rule 5.7 5.7 In Show jumping only, a combination which is within 6 points of the next level above may choose to compete officially in that next level. Eligible combinations may not compete in the same class in more than one level.</p> <p>Amend Event rule 24.7 to read: (new rules underlined) 24.7. SHOWJUMPING EVENTS <u>24.7.1 Two classes per level shall be nominated as points earning classes. Combinations shall receive performance point/s for their highest placing in a nominated class at the event.</u> <u>24.7.2 Combinations with fewer than 6 points required to progress to the next level, may compete officially one level higher than their current assessed level. Eligible combinations are not permitted to compete in the same class in more than one level.</u> 24.7.4. Points earning classes must have a first round which is not against the clock and a jump off against the clock where at least 50% of the fences are at maximum height for the level. The first round must have a time allowed and a time limit (eg: AM5, 2 Phase or AM7). If 2 Phase is used, the 2nd phase must comprise 6 obstacles, one of which may be a combination, and be judged according to SJ rule 55.5.2,55.5.4 or 55.5.6 24.7.5. In Showjumping Events which have preliminary rounds/phases, competitors who fail to jump clear in the preliminary rounds/phases will be ineligible for performance points</p>

<p>LA rule 8</p>	<p>Amend Level Assessment rule 8 to read 8. RE-ASSESSMENT TO A LOWER LEVEL 8.1. Re-assessment to a lower Level of currently assessed Combinations may be permitted in exceptional circumstances. Requests for reassessment must be submitted</p>

	<p>for consideration to the Level Assessment Sub-Committee, via a Level Assessor, on the form contained in Appendix 4 of this Manual. All relevant performance cards must be submitted with the application.</p> <p>8.2. <u>Requests from combinations which progressed to their current level through accumulation of performance points must be supported by a Senior Level Assessor.</u></p> <p>8.3. Re-assessment to a lower level may only be applied for once per Combination per discipline.</p>

3PE rules	<p><i>Changes to Style requirements</i></p> <p>Amend Style requirements as follows:</p> <p><u>Gate –</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Levels 4/5 to remain as walk • Levels 3/2 to change to Walk or Trot • Levels 1/Ad to change to Trot or Canter <p><u>Style Phase Penalty table -</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove from the “0” column - Move Item, Jug and Switch cup – this will be changed to reflected in the score by an insufficient mark. • Change of lead and incorrect Gait to be classed as an “error of Test” not an “error of course”. • Refusal/Resistance to be reduce from 15 sec to 8 sec <p><u>Speed Phase Penalty table</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Failing to complete an obstacle (with exception to the ring) eg; Switch cup: • Failure to replace. Move item: Failure to replace – to be removed from the elimination column. • Switch cup: Failure to replace. Move item: Failure to replace to receive a 5 sec penalty • Knocking Pole/s off the jump stand to be a 5 sec penalty. • Refusal/Resistance to be reduce from 15 sec to 8 sec. • Stepping off the bridge/varied footing/bank: elimination.
Event rules	<p>Amend Event Rules as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 23.2 ... in Jumping disciplines and 3PE, the rider may choose to compete at their previous level in accordance with Event rule 5.6 • Delete 23.8 • Page 15 - Table 2: Add ‘3Phase Equitation and Show Jumping’ • Page 17 - Delete Table 6 • Add rule 24.13 THREE PHASE EQUITATION (3PE), 24.13.1 Points are awarded for overall placings.
3PE rules	<p>Amend rule 2.1 to read</p> <p>Combinations will compete at their assessed level for 3PE. Riders must present a valid membership and 3PE performance card prior to riding unless the event is advertised as a ‘no cards’ event. At ‘no-cards’ events organisers must confirm membership and level of riders prior to the day of competition.</p>

General Rules	<p>Add</p> <p>16. FIRST AID AT RALLIES AND CLINICS</p> <p>16.1 The provision of first aid at rallies and clinics is to be addressed in the Club Risk Management policy.</p> <p>16.2 A risk assessment of planned activities is to be undertaken. Where lack of first aid support results in very serious or extremely serious risk, the activity must not proceed.</p>
