3PE SCORING GUIDE	
1.	 Overall placings* of riders is <u>compulsory following all 3 phases</u>; Riders are to be awarded overall placings as per Event rule 25.1 eg. Trophies, sashes or ribbons must be given to at least one quarter of the Competitors. Any ribbons over and/or above these requirements are to be at the discretion of the Organising Committee. *Same as a Horse Trials or Combined Training and NOT as a Champion & Reserve Champion
	To calculate the overall place getters (3PE Rule 18);
2.	 Competitors in each phase are allocated points from first to last placing according to the number of competitors in the section. Eg 12 in the class, 1st place receives 12 points, 2nd 11 points, 3rd 10 points. *For equal placings please refer to rule 18.3
	 The competitor with the highest total points <u>over the three phases</u> will be declared the winner. The second highest is in 2nd place. Third highest in 3rd place etc
	 In the event of equal overall points, the combination with the best Obstacles Style result will place higher. It the tie remains, then the Dressage result is considered.
3.	Competitors <i>must complete</i> all three phases to be eligible for a placing. E.g. If a rider is eliminated from one phase they are eliminated from the entire competition and not allowed to receive an overall placings.
4.	Once all scores are calculated - Section/Class final scores must be posted and available for all competitors review for 30 mins before placings are awarded.
5.	Protests regarding the scores <u>must</u> be lodged within 30 minutes of the relevant Section/Class final scores being posted.
6.	Dressage tests and Style Score Sheets <i>must</i> be available for competitors once the final scores are posted.
7.	Speed and Accuracy score sheets <i>must</i> be posted with the Final Scores for review by competitors.
8.	Should a protest be received which results in a score/placing amendment, the final scores are to be reposted and the 30 mins to start again.
9.	Once the 30mins has ended and no protests are received, the placings may be awarded.
Performance Points	
1.	Points are awarded for overall placings up to 4 th place (see Event rule 24)
2.	Competitors <i>must</i> receive a minimum of 60% in the Dressage and Style phases
3.	Competitors <i>must complete</i> all three phases to be eligible for performance points.
4.	Performance points are to be added to the 3PE card only.
5.	If the event is a cardless event, an email to each overall placegetter is to be sent out advising them of their performance points.
Awarding Other Prizes	
1.	Awarding individual placings for each phase is optional.
2.	Special awards such as, Judges Choice or Encouragement awards, are at the discretion of the Organising committee and sponsorships.
