COMBINATIONS MUST RIDE EITHER OFFICIAL OR UNOFFICIAL CLASS – NOT BOTH UNOFFICIAL 'PICK N MIX' COMBINED TRAINING

- This competition is designed to be a low key preparation event for local, upcoming Horse Trials. Plaiting not required. Club T-shirts encouraged. Open to current HRCAV members only.
- Combinations must be assessed for Dressage and Combined Training. Combinations may not compete above their Dressage or Combined Training level.
- You choose your Dressage level and Jumping height. These can be different levels. Your penalties from your jumping are added to your dressage score and you are placed accordingly at your dressage level.
- There is no equalizers between the levels for jumping.
 - ie. Charlotte D rides level 3 dressage, scoring 35. She then rides a level 5 SJ with 2 rails or 10 penalties. Her final score in level 3 is 45.
 - Edwina A rides level 3 dressage, scoring 44. She then rides a level 4 SJ with 0 penalties final score is 44.
 - Andrew H rides level 3 dressage scoring 46. He then rides a level 3 SJ with 1 refusal or 10 penalties. His final score is 56.
 - Edwina places first and Charlotte D is second and Andrew H is third.
- The aim of these Unofficial classes is to allow those with green horses, those with experience/level restrictions and those who are not confident jumpers to have a go.
- Separate ribbons for the 'official' and 'unofficial' sections. Combinations competing in Unofficial section are not eligible for performance points or points for annual awards and performances do not count as a qualifier for TTT purposes.
- Riders may compete additional horses in official classes on the day

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- CARDLESS EVENT
- Events will be conducted in accordance with HRCAV rules & regulations. Open to members of clubs affiliated with HRCAV only.
- Competitors cannot jump higher than their assessed level in Official or Unofficial classes.
- Competitors must present to gear check 20 minutes prior to riding the first class, failure to do so may result in elimination.
- All competitors are to supply their own numbers to be displayed on both sides of the horse
- An Approved, tagged helmet MUST be worn by ALL competitors in all jumping phases. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
- Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of posting of interim results accompanied by a \$20 refundable deposit. The ground jury's decision is final and no secondary protests may be lodged.
- The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any Class or Competition; to divide any Class; to alter the advertised times or to refuse entry with or without stating the reason.
- Sale & District Adult Riding Club Inc doesn't accept liability for any accidents/damage/injury/illness/loss to any person/horse/property.
- Dogs MUST be on a LEASH at all times. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
- In the event of extreme weather forecast the committee will make a decision on if the event goes ahead based on the 4.30pm Bureau of Meteorology forecast on FRIDAY 5th January. If this forecast is for 36 degrees or higher we will postpone/cancel with refunds minus a \$5 admin fee.
- In the event of hot weather there is shade around the edge of the venue and there will be plentiful water available for cooling of horses. Free water will be supplied to riders as they leave competition arenas.
