Dressage Caller: \$10 per test. Book with entries via Event Secretary.

Conditions of Entry:

- This event will be run under HRCAV Rules & Regulations.
- **CARDLESS EVENT**. Cards will be pre-validated by Event Secretary.
- Riders to ride at their assessed level for 3PE.
- Riders must present to gear check at least 20 minutes prior to dressage and obstacle event. Failure to present will incur elimination.
- Riders must display numbers on both sides of either saddle blanket or bridle. Competitors to supply their own numbers. Registered club colours and approved safety helmet/boots must be worn.
- Protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of posting scores, accompanied by a \$20 deposit. Ground Jury's decision is final. No secondary protests will be entered into.
- No refunds after the closing date without a medical or veterinary certificate to be received within 14 days of the event. A \$10 admin fee will apply to all refunds.
- South West Working Equitation Club Inc accepts no liability for accidents, damage, injury, illness or loss to any person, horse or property.
- Prizes must be collected. Sashes & ribbons can be mailed if address and a \$5 postage fee are provided.
- Dogs must be secured or on a leash at all times. There are sheep in paddocks adjacent to the venue, and 1080 fox bait is used throughout the year in the pine plantations next door.
