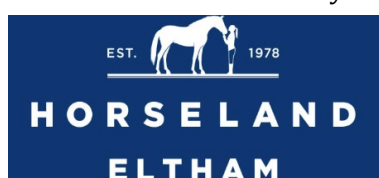

- CARDLESS EVENT AS PER HRCV RULES**
- There will be no refunds after the closing date without a medical or veterinary certificate to be received by Horse Comps within 14 days of the event. An administration charge of \$10 will be retained on any scratchings prior to the draw being released. After the draw has been released the administration charge will be 25% per scratching.
- Yarrambat Adult Riding Club do not accept any liability for accidents, damage, injury or illness or loss to any person, horse, or property.
- It is the responsibility of the Club President or Secretary to ensure team entries comply with the requirements of Event Rule 40.7
- All teams must supply a volunteer for approximately 3 hours. Failure of a volunteer helper to report for duty may result in elimination of the team
- Swabbing may occur.
- Protests including scoring queries must be lodged within 30 mins of posting results & must be accompanied by a \$20 deposit. Disputes regarding team placings must be accompanied by a \$20 non-refundable fee.
- The ground jury's decision is final. No secondary protests can be entered.
- Dogs on a lead at all times and at all times kept away from the competition arenas.
- Prizes must be collected. Tests and rosettes may be posted if a SSAE is supplied.
