SEPTEMBER 2020 TESTS TO BE USED – PRIX CAPRILLI TESTS UPLOADED TO EVENT SECRETARY

SPECIAL EVENT - PRIX CAPRILLI DRESSAGE TESTS!

Prix Caprilli is dressage with some jumps added as a more complete test of training. Two or three low jumps are placed in the arena. The regular transitions, gaits, circles and changes of direction are called for with the addition of either trotting or cantering (as you go up the levels) over the placed jumps. Refusals and knock downs are scored as errors.

- Combinations to compete at their assessed Dressage level.
- Maximum jump height for Levels 3 to Advanced is 65cm. Maximum jump height for Levels 4 and 5 is 50cm. Level 3 and above riders who wish to compete in the Level 4 test will have a 5 point penalty applied for each Dressage level down.
- Combinations in Levels 3 to Advanced must be assessed at a minimum of level 4 in a jumping discipline. Level 4 & 5 combinations must be assessed at a minimum of level 5 in a jumping discipline.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This event is open to members of riding clubs affiliated with the HRC AV and will be conducted under HRC AV rules and regulations.
2. Dressage competitors **must** ride at their assessed level and can ride at one level above. Maximum of 4 tests on the day (including Prix Caprilli).
3. Card Free Event – Riders membership and level assessment will be validated. Riders should bring their cards but do not need to show them at the office. Riders who have gained points will be notified via email to update their card.
4. Competitors must present to Gear Check at least 20 minutes before the first class.
5. Riders must supply their own number for both sides of their horse & ride in approved riding boots, helmets & club colours.
6. Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of the posting of interim results and must be accompanied by a \$20 deposit. The decision of the Ground Jury is final.
7. If medical attention is deemed necessary, an ambulance will be called at the rider's expense.
8. No refunds will be issued after the closing date unless a valid veterinary or doctor's certificate is provided within 14 days of the completion of the event. All refunds will have a \$10 admin fee deducted.
9. As a condition of entry, the rider is aware that Mt Duneed Adult Riding Club accepts no liability for any injury, damage or loss to any person, horse, property or equipment.
10. Dogs must be leashed at all times and not disruptive to competitors or elimination may occur.
11. The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class or competition; to divide any class; to alter the advertised times; to refuse entry with or without stating the reason.
12. Prizes must be collected during the event. Only cards and sashes will be mailed out after the event.
13. HRC AV Extreme Weather Policy & Horse welfare shall be observed, should weather conditions be unsuitable for running a safe event the Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel. Competitors will be advised immediately.
