CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- This event is open to members of riding clubs affiliated with the HRCav and will be conducted under HRCav rules and regulations
- All riders must present to gear check at least 20 minutes prior to their first test
- Competitors must provide their own bridle or saddle cloth numbers
- Approved safety helmets must be worn at all times while mounted
- There will be no refunds after closing date unless accompanied by a medical or veterinary certificate to be received by the event secretary no later than 14 days after the event
- All refunds are minus a \$10 admin fee
- Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of results and accompanied by a \$20 fee
- The ground jury's decision is final - No secondary protests can be entered
- Yarra Glen ARC does not accept any liability for accidents, damage, injury, illness or loss to any person, horse or property
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class or competition, to divide any class, to alter the advertised times, to refuse entry without stating a reason
- Competitors must ride at their assessed level and may also ride a test at the level above
- Dogs must be on a lead at all times - No dogs near the competition arenas or warm up
- Riders must lead their horse through the car park and mount in warm up

SERIES RULES

1. Participation in the Series is open to all financial members of the HRCav and Associated Clubs.
2. Combinations may compete at their assessed Dressage Level and the next Level above as per HRCav Event Rule 3.2.1.
3. Unless otherwise specified in the rules, HRCav Dressage & Event Rules will apply.
4. The YGARC Series is made up of three individual official HRCav Dressage Competitions.
5. Entry into the series is included as part of riders' entry fees in the competitions.
6. Each of the three individual competitions comprising the YGARC Dressage Series is made up of two components:
 - a. The normal day's Level placings and for which sashes/trophies will be awarded as per HRCav rule 25
 - b. Final total points from the test contribute to the series scoring.
7. The final presentation to the winners/placegetters in the Series will be made at the end of the last competition of the series.
8. Scores will be allocated for the Level in which they were gained by the rider/horse combination. Scores remain in the level they are achieved in. In the event of a combination proceeding to the next level, scores attained at the previous level **do not** carry over into the next level.
9. Riders may compete on more than one horse in the Series, with each rider/horse earning points as separate combinations.
10. Where there is a change of either rider or horse in a combination during the Series, the new combination's points tally starts afresh from that point.
11. In the event of equal placings the following process will occur to eliminate any equal placings:
 - i. The rider who has competed in all 3 competitions will be placed higher.
 - ii. The rider that has the higher number of first placings is placed higher.
 - iii. A summation of percentages will be used to break any ties.
