CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- HRCV OFFICIAL points competition, run under H.R.C.A.V. rules & regulations. Riders must be current HRCV members.
- Current Membership & Showing Card and Official HRCV Entry Form must be presented to the card secretary 30 minutes prior to the commencement of your first class.
- All riders must wear approved helmets and full club uniform.
- Riders to supply own numbers, to be displayed on both sides of the horse or in a number holder.
- All numbered classes and Championships, count towards Highpoint award In the event of equal Highpoint placing the winner will be determined on count back of placing in Rider class, followed by Ridden Mount and then MMS.
- Classes may be combined if insufficient numbers.
- No refund of pre-entries after close of entries unless vet/medical certificate received by 8:30 am on Sunday 4th February 2024.
