CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Open to members of riding clubs affiliated with HRCav and conducted under HRCav rules and regulations.
- Competitors to provide their own bridle or saddlecloth numbers to be displayed on both sides of the horse.
- Uniform and gear as per HRCav rules and helmets must be tagged.
- Riders must present for gear check 10 minutes before riding out time.
- Riders to compete in pairs: riders under 16 must be paired with an adult.
- Riders must indicate their Navigation Ride level on entry form and their partner.
- All refunds are subject to a \$10 Administration fee.
- No refunds after entries close unless a valid veterinary or doctor's certificate is provided, within 14 days of the event.
- Protests must be lodged within 30min of posting results and accompanied by a \$20 fee.
- MDEC reserved the right to refuse entry, cancel the event or change the program without notice.
- MDEC committee does not accept any liability for accidents or damages.
- Hoof protection is recommended.
