CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- This competition will be run under HRCAV Rules and Regulations.
- THIS IS A CARD FREE EVENT.
- Competitors MUST enter at their assessed level & have the option to ride one level higher if numbers permit.
- Competitors are to provide their own bridle/saddlecloth numbers. Numbers are to be worn on both sides of the horse.
- Competitors must present at gear check 20 minutes prior to their first class wearing approved riding helmets and riding boots. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
- Protests must be lodged within 30mins of posting interim scores & must be accompanied by \$20.00.
- No secondary protests may be entered into. The decision of the Ground Jury is final.
- After closing of entries no refunds will be issued unless a valid Veterinary or Doctor's Certificate is provided within 14 days of the completion of the event. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- BDARC accepts no responsibility for injury, damage or loss to any competitor/spectator/horse/equipment/property.
- HRCAV extreme weather policy and horse welfare shall be observed. Should weather conditions be unsuitable for running a safe event, the committee reserve the right to postpone or cancel. Competitors will be advised immediately. Please note that in such circumstances, an administration fee of \$10 per entry will be withheld to help recover incurred costs.
- BDARC reserves the right to cancel any class, to divide any class, to alter the advertised times and to decline any entry without stating a reason.
- All competitors are expected to pick up their horse's manure and dispose of it in the prescribed manure bay. BSEC Committee of Management has a policy that <u>no manure is to be put around trees</u>.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED AT THIS EVENT
