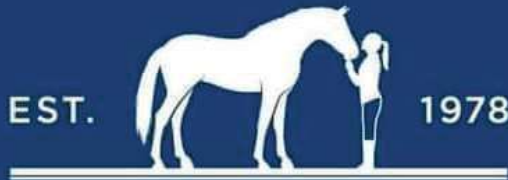

Proudly sponsored by Horseland, the Top Club awards aims to recognise those Clubs which promote interest in equestrian sport and train, coach and encourage their members. The winning Club will receive a \$2000 Horseland voucher and commemorative plaque, while the Top Regional Club and the Top Small Club will both receive a \$1000 voucher and plaque.

The award is performance point based with a limit on the number of points any one member can contribute to their Club total.

To be eligible for the award, Clubs must:

1. hold regular coaching or training rallies/clinics (minimum 6 per year) for their members and
2. conduct at least one HRCAV official event and/or host an official's training or exam day during the award period.

Clubs which co-host with another HRCAV Club shall satisfy this criteria. Clubs are required to provide proof of meeting the eligibility criteria before the end of the award period.
