- In the case of an equal placing in the Highpoint Award, the winner will be determined on the highest placing in Ridden Mount, then Rider, then MMS HRC AV class.

BEYOND THE TRACK

Conditions of entry

- To be run under HRC AV Rules and Regulations and HRC AV standard conditions of entry
- Riddells Creek Pony Club Inc. requires all competitors to clean up & take their horse's manure home or leave in designated areas. DO NOT put manure around trees.
- Card Free Event – Riders membership and level assessment will be re validated. Riders should bring their cards with them but do not need to show them at the office. Riders who have gained points will be notified to update their card.
- Competitors to provide their own bridle or saddle blanket numbers to be displayed as per the relevant rules for dressage and showing.
- Approved helmets must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
- Riders must ride at their assessed level to be eligible to ride additional test/s at the level above. Maximum 4 tests per event rule 3.2.1.
- NO refund after closing date without a vet or doctor's certificate within 14 days of the event. Refunds as per ER 16.3. Facility fee is non-refundable.
- Riders must present for gear check at least 20 minutes before the first test. Show gear check will be done by judge.
- Reservation of right as per ER 15.1. The ground Jury's decision is final.
- Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of interim results and be accompanied by a \$20 refundable deposit.
- Neither Bolinda Riding Club Inc. nor Riddells Creek Pony Club Inc. accepts any liability for any damage, injury, illness or loss arising from this event to any persons, horses or equipment.
- NO dogs allowed, even in cars/floats.
- The walk/trot jackpot is an unofficial class. You must be level assessed on your horse to compete. Equaliser points will be removed from your test based on the level that you are assessed at (Advanced/Level 1 – 20 points; Level 2 – 15 points; level 3 – 10 points, level 4 – 5 points and level 5 no adjustment).
