CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

• Event open to all current members of Clubs affiliated with the HRCAV.

◆ CARD FREE EVENT

- Competitors must enter official classes at their assessed level and can enter one level above if chosen (but must ride at assessed level too)
- The Organisers reserve the right to give priority entry to combinations entering dressage tests at assessed level if oversubscribed.
- ◆ All refunds are subject to a \$10 administration fee. No refunds after the closing date, unless prior to ride time to office@eventsecretary.com.au and a Vet or Doctor's Certificate is provided within 14 days after the event.
- Riders must wear club uniform, approved helmet & boots. Riders to supply numbers visible on both sides of the horse.
- Riders must present for gear check at least 20 minutes prior to each ride.
- Reservation Of Right as per ER 15.1
- Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of the posting of interim results with a refundable fee of \$20. The decision of the Ground Jury is final; no secondary protests will be entered into.
- Boneo ARC will not be liable for any damage, loss or injury to any rider or spectator within or outside the grounds.
- Lunging of horses must be restricted to the designated round yards
- Prizes must be collected during the event; only sashes will be mailed out after the event. A stamped, self-addressed envelope needs to be provided.

The Walk Trot Test is an unofficial class. You must be level assessed on your horse to compete. Equalizer points will be implemented, based on the level that you are assessed at as specified below:

Level Adv = 20 points deducted	Level 3 = 10 points deducted
Level 1 = 20 points deducted	Level 4 = 5 points deducted
Level 2 = 15 points deducted	Level 5 = 0 points deducted
