- Riders must supply their own numbers. Numbers will be allocated prior to the day.
- No refunds without a doctors/veterinarian certificate provided within 14 days of the event.
- Classes may be split or combined at judge's discretion.
- All numbered classes count towards Highpoint. If equal Highpoint occurs, winner will be determined by countback to highest placing in Rider class followed by Mount class & then MMS HRCV.
