CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Open to current members of riding clubs affiliated with the HRCav & conducted under HRCav rules & regulations.
- Riders must present for gear check 20 mins prior to Dressage and again prior to Showjumping phases.
- **CARDLESS EVENT.** Valid membership and Dressage and Combined Training cards **must be presented if requested.**
- Competitors to provide their own bridle or saddle blanket numbers to be displayed on both sides of the horse.
- Approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted. Helmets must be tagged for Combined Training.
- Dressage Jackpot combinations are to enter and compete at their assessed HRCav dressage level.
- If class numbers are low, two adjacent levels may be combined with prior notice given to those who would be affected with additional penalty points.
- No refund of entry fee after close of entries (unless vet/medical certificate received) within 14 days of the event.
- Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of posting results. The ground jury's decision is final.
- Reservation Of Right as Per ER 15.1
- Dogs are allowed but must be on a leash whilst the event is running.
- Tumbarumba Adult Riding Club Committee does not accept any liability for any accident, injury, damage, or loss arising from attendance at this event.
