- This is a CARDLESS event per HRCAV Rules.
- There will be no refunds after the closing date without medical or veterinary certificate to be received by Event Secretary within 14 days of the event. An administration charge of \$10 will be retained on any scratching prior to the draw being released. After the draw has been released the administration charge will be 25% per scratching.
- Riders to wear club uniform, approved helmet and boots.
- Dogs are to be kept on a lead at all times and kept away from competition/warm up areas.
- Riders must present for gear check at least 20 minutess prior.

- Dressage tests are September 2020 edition.
- · Competitors must supply their own number.
- Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of the posting of interim results with a refundable fee of \$20.
- The decision of the Ground Jury is final; no secondary protests will be entered into.
