CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. This event is open to HRCVA members and will be run under HRCVA Navigation Ride Rules.
2. Riders to compete in pairs.
3. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel the event if insufficient entries are received.
4. Valid Membership and Navigation Ride performance cards must be handed to the Card Steward on arrival. New Navigation cards (introduced 1/9/2014) must be presented with a recorded assessment of the horse being ridden.
5. Riders under 16 years must be paired with an adult rider.
6. Riders to present for gear check at least 20 minutes prior to ride out time. Clothing and saddlery must comply with HRCVA Rules.
7. Bridle/saddle cloth numbers to be provided by riders and worn on both sides of the horse.
8. No refund of entry fees after closing date unless accompanied by a vet or medical certificate supplied before 22 July 2019.
9. Entries will only be accepted on the official HRCVA entry form. Riders must indicate their Navigation Ride level on entry form. Entry forms can be downloaded from www.hrcva.com.au
10. The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entry with or without stating a reason.
11. It is recommended that horses be shod or have hoof protection due to some stony terrain.

13. Camping and showers are available at the grounds.
14. BYO yards. Yards must comply with HRCVA event rule 22.
15. Helmets must be tagged.
16. Tallarook Family Riding Club do not accept any liability for accidents or damages.
