- All Competitors must supply their own number to be displayed on both sides of the horse or on the breastplate.
- All competitors must wear approved helmets, boots and club uniform.
- Neither PADARC or HRCV accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage or injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- No refunds or unused tickets. No refunds after the closing date – unless a vet/medical certificate is lodged within 14 days of the events.
- All numbered classes are eligible for High point.
- In the eventuality of equal Highpoint Winner, countback will be determined on the highest placing in the Rider class, followed by the Ridden then MMS
- NO other rider is allowed to ride your horse on the day of competition.
