Conditions of Entry:

- This will be a **CARD FREE EVENT** run under HRC AV rules and regulations. Valid Membership and Dressage performance cards must be presented to the Event Secretary if requested
- Riders must compete at their assessed level, unless entering Walk/Trot*
- Competitors to provide own bridle and/or saddlecloth numbers in accordance with HRC AV rulings
- Reservation of Right as per ER 15.1
- Riders must present to gear check at least 20 minutes prior to competing
- No refunds after closing date unless a veterinary or doctor's certificate is provided by 20th June. \$10 administration fee applies to all cancellations
- The decision of the Ground Jury is final. Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes of posting interim results, accompanied by a \$20 deposit. No secondary protests may be entered into
- Phoenix Riding Club does not accept liability for accidents, damage, injury, illness or loss to any person, horse or property
- In the event that the CFA declares an Extreme Weather Warning, the event will be cancelled, and entry fees refunded, less administration costs
- *Walk/Trot entries must be level assessed and a handicap system will apply. Combinations may not enter any other level within the competition and a handicapping points system will be applied following the system used for Combined Training: Level 4 -5 points, Level 3 - 10 points, Level 2 - 15 points etc.
